
ZAGREB

More than 25 individual Christmas Markets are spread throughout the city's main squares and promenades, each with its own unique theme and atmosphere, yet blending together to give the feeling of one all-encompassing market.

AMADRIA PARK HOTEL CAPITAL- 5* HOTEL IN THE HEART OF ZAGREB

Built in the early 1920s, both the building's exterior and its rich, decorative interior are almost perfectly preserved, featuring rich Art Deco and Art Nouveau influences. The rooms are well-appointed and elegantly decorated, combining the grandeur of early 20th century architecture with the upmarket elegance of a modern hotel; a perfect example of classic Zagreb character and flair.











ZAGREB

Begin your day with a private guided walking tour of the Upper town & Lower town of historic Zagreb.

Your tour begins with a visit Zagreb's main square, Trg Bana Josipa Jelačića, before continuing to the historic settlements on Kaptol and Gradec. You'll have the opportunity to learn about Croatia's largest Cathedral and visit the bustling Dolac farmers' Market, as well as see St. Mark's Church with its colorful roof tiles. After, you'll visit the Christmas Market at Zrinjevac Park, illuminated by hundreds of trees covered in glittering lights lining the main pathway. Charming white wooden huts sell gifts handcrafted by local artisans and serve hearty winter fare. Live musical performances occasionally take place in the central pavilion. Finish your tour at King Tomislav square, home to Croatia's largest ice-skating rink.

After your guided tour, enjoy your afternoon and evening at leisure to explore at your own pace.









VARAŽDIN & TRAKOŠĆAN CASTLE

Begin by departing Zagreb in the morning by private car and driver to Varaždin, a city on the Drava River, known as the, "City of the Angels."

A quaint, beautifully preserved city, Varaždin is appreciated for its Baroque and Rococo architecture. Having once briefly served as Croatia's capital, this splendid small city has much to offer curious travelers. Together with your guide, stroll through the charming cobblestoned center learning of the city's past, stopping by the town's delightful museums, churches, and medieval castle before finishing with a steamy cup of mulled wine at the festive Christmas Market.

Continue your journey to explore the Krapina-Zagorije region and stop to visit Trakošćan Castle.

Originally built in the late 13th century, the castle is a cultural treasure, rising above the forest as if in a fairy tale. In 1953, it was opened to the public as a museum, home to examples of baroque furniture and historical weapons. Encircled by romantic gardens, and overlooking a picturesque lake, the castle grounds should not be missed.

Return to Zagreb in the late afternoon to enjoy your evening at leisure.

Finally, explore the Christmas Market of Novo Mesto. Our local guide will introduce you to the secrets of this small historic town and capital of the region.

Surrounded by the lofty peaks of the Julian Alps, Ljubljana is a lively, green city which exudes effortless charm.

Begin your day with a private guided walking tour of Ljubljana's Old Town.

Explore the historic heart of the city and learn about its stunning Art Nouveau buildings, the work of world-famous architect Jože Plečnik. Visit Ljubljana's most important landmarks, such as Prešeren Square, Triple Bridge, and Ljubljana Castle, which crowns a hill east of the Old Town. The castle's tower is depicted on the city's coat of arms, mounted by a dragon, the symbol of the city, representing power, courage, and greatness – an apropos image for the cultural, educational, economic, and political center of Slovenia.

After your guided tour, enjoy your afternoon and evening at leisure exploring the city's vibrant Christmas Market, known as the Festive Fair.

The market comes to life in the evening with its Christmas lighting display. The theme of the lighting display changes every year but is inspired by the infinite expanses of the universe. Past themes have included Cosmic Ljubljana, The Path of Life, Bearers of Light, and A Celebration of Existence, among others. The result is both beautiful and uniquely Ljubljana. Soak up the atmosphere as you enjoy some mulled wine and local street food.

Nestled in the foothills of the Julian Alps, glacial Lake Bled shimmers like a jewel, its mirrored surface reflecting the lush forest and snow-capped peaks that surround it.

Depart Ljubljana in the morning by private car and driver to Lake Bled. Check into your hotel and enjoy the day at leisure.

In the center of the lake sits a small island, home to the picturesque Assumption of Mary Church and object of many fables. To reach the island, ride a traditional Pletna, a wooden, awning-covered boat, rowed by a standing oarsman, and climb the 99 stone steps up to the church, bell tower, curacy and provost's house, and small hermitage. On Bled's shored, its charming lakeside town plays host to the annual Christmas Market, known as the Bled Winter Fairytale. Located on the Lakeside Promenade, wooden stalls adorned with twinkling lights offer a range of festive food, drink, and gifts. Those wishing to explore Slovenia's natural wonders will find Bled an ideal home base, conveniently located within easy reach of Vintgar Gorge, Triglav National Park, and Lake Bohinj. Adventure seekers are sure to enjoy the multitude of winter sport possibilities such as skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, dog sledding, ice-climbing, and more.

The city sits snuggly in the northern foothills of the Alps, set against a backdrop of snow-capped peaks, cut in half by the curves of the Salzach River. Although a worthwhile destination all year round, Salzburg is most magical during the holidays, when the wonderfully preserved Altstadt serves as a picture-perfect backdrop for perusing the city's lively Christmas Market. One of the oldest Advent Markets in Europe, the Salzburg Christkindlmarkt offers incomparable holiday ambiance – bells ring out from onion-domed churches, the scent of fresh pine mingles with the aroma of cinnamon-sprinkled mulled wine in the crisp winter air, and cheerful groups huddle around festive market stalls. With close to 100 stalls, the Salzburg Christkindlmarkt offers plenty to see and do while still retaining an intimacy uncharacteristic of most markets this size.

Salzburg's historic center radiates Old World charm - a UNESCO World Heritage site home to Renaissance and Baroque buildings, palaces, concert halls, and monasteries. Together with your guide, explore the city's most notable monuments such as the Salzburg Dom, Residenz Palace, birthplace of Mozart on charming Getreidegasse, fortress of Hohensalzburg, and Mirabell Palace while learning about the city's rich Christmas traditions.

After your tour, your guide will drop you off at the location of your private Apple Strudel & Christmas Cookies Baking Experience .

Prepare an original Austrian apple strudel from scratch as well as Vanilla Kipferl, traditional Austrian Christmas cookies, under the guidance and instruction of your chef. While they bake, enjoy some hot glühwein (mulled wine) and a bowl of goulash.

Together with your guide, begin by departing Salzburg in the morning by private car and driver to the Salzkammergut, or "Domaine of Salt."

This picturesque region of lakes and Alpine ranges garnered its name from the rock salt found deep below its idyllic mountains. Begin your excursion with a stop in Gosau to enjoy a horse drawn sleigh ride through snow-covered meadows and woods while bundled under warm blankets. Your next stop will be the Alpine village of Hallstatt, a tiny village tucked between mountains famous for its charm and beauty. Enjoy a stroll around the town and lunch in one of the lakeside restaurants. After, continue to St. Wolfgang, being sure to see its 14th-century church and stroll its rustic Christmas market stalls. If time permits, on your way back to Salzburg, make a short stop in Mondsee to see the Basilica Minor St Michael, which was the filming location of the iconic wedding scene in "The Sound of Music."

Enjoy your evening at leisure in Salzburg.







THE SILENT NIGHT CHAPEL

Depart Salzburg in the morning by private car and driver to Český Krumlov with a stop along the way to discover Oberndorf, the Austrian village where the classic song "Silent Night" was first composed and performed.

Beloved holiday classic "Silent Night" was performed for the first time by Franz Xaver Gruber and Joseph Mohr in the St. Nikolaus Church during Christmas mass in 1818. Since then, it has been translated into roughly 300 languages and dialects around the world, making it one of the most famous holiday songs ever written. Start with a visit to the Silent Night Museum, where displays of unique memorabilia and interactive stations teach of the Christmas carol's origin. Next, visit the Silent Night Memorial Chapel, which was erected in 1937 on the site where the St. Nikolaus Church once stood. Finally, take a stroll around the village's charming Christmas market before continuing on toward Český Krumlov.

Your day concludes with drop off at your hotel in Český Krumlov. After check in, enjoy your afternoon and evening at leisure.







BELLEVUE - 4* HOTEL IN ČESKÝ KRUMLOV'S HISTORIC CENTER

This fairy tale town and UNESCO World Heritage Site is one of the most picturesque in Europe. Marvel at the town's magnificent architecture, from the iconic 14th century castle perched atop a rocky promontory, to the splendid townhouses which occupy the Old Town below.

A popular tourist destination, Advent presents a quieter side not seen in spring or summer. A charming market fills the main square, and festive atmosphere permeates the entire city.

Begin your day with a private guided walking tour exploring the towns main attractions.

After your tour, visit the newly restored Minorite and Poor Clares Monasteries. Spend some time exploring the craft workshops which aim to introduce visitors to the traditional crafts which were done in medieval monasteries and cities. Visit the tailor to see traditional medieval attire and try on the costumes. Similar interactive experiences can be had visiting the blacksmith, the potter, the bookbinder, shoemaker, and more.

For over a thousand years, the fairytale city of Prague has stood straddling the banks of the VItava River; a microcosm of Central Europe; a cobbled maze of stunning architecture, hidden gardens, and cozy sidewalk cafes.

At once both imperial and cosmopolitan, Prague is a lively, dynamic, and constantly developing city, where past and present intertwine to create an atmosphere of romance and wonder. Prague rewards its visitors with endless potential for exploration and unexpected discoveries. At no time is this more evident than during Christmas, when the Czech capital's many charming squares play host to vibrant Vánoční Trhy (Christmas Markets). The sound of children's choirs and carol singers echo off the ornate facades of historic buildings, bouncing among the richly decorated wooden stalls, and mingling with the laughter and chatter of jolly patrons. Live potted trees create the feeling of an enchanted forest, though they are dwarfed by the towering spruce which shimmers as the magnificent centerpiece of the Old Town Square market.

The property features sleek, modern design in each of its 59 rooms and suites, as well as comfortable and inviting common spaces. Feel at home in the stylish, multi-roomed complex known as the M Lounge in the hotel's lower level, or in the tranquil spa upstairs. Original artworks and temporary exhibitions find their home throughout the property making it a truly unique creative environment. The on-site restaurant is one of the city's best steakhouses.

Begin your day with a private guided walking tour of Prague's Old Town (Staré Mesto), the throbbing heart of the city.

You'll have the opportunity to see the Old Town Hall, Astrological Clock and the Church of Our Lady before Týn, whose twin Gothic spires make it an unmistakable landmark. In fact, Prague is often referred to as the "City of a hundred Spires," as the city's skyline is punctuated by dozens of steeples and towers stretching toward the heavens. You'll also visit the Charles Bridge. Built in the 14th century, it stood as the only means of crossing the Vltava until 1841, securing Prague's position as an important trade route between Eastern and Western Europe. It was named for Charles IV, the first king of Bohemia to also bear the title of Holy Roman Emperor. Known as the father of the Czech Republic, Charles IV ruled during Prague's golden age and oversaw the founding of Central Europe's first university. A short walk away, the New Town (Nové Město) is home to many of Prague's most important museums as well as Wenceslas Square, the site of demonstrations during the Velvet Revolution in 1989.

After your guided tour, enjoy your afternoon and evening at leisure to explore at your own pace.









- MORNING PRIVATE WALKING TOUR OF PRAGUE CASTLE WITH LOCAL GUIDE
- AFTERNOON & EVENING AT LEISURE IN PRAGUE

Today you'll begin by exploring the Castle District (Hradčany), atop a hill on the western bank of the Vltava.

Together with your private guide, you will explore the massive complex which serves as the political and cultural center of the country. Prague castle, which dates back to the ninth century, is the largest castle complex in the world, spanning roughly 18 acres and housing cathedrals, chapels, royal palaces, and gardens. Even today it remains as the seat of the Czech government with the president still working within its gates.

After your guided tour, enjoy your afternoon and evening at leisure.

You may wish to explore Lesser Town (Malá Strana), which is just down the hill from Prague Castle. Once the home of Prague's nobles, today this charming district houses a number of foreign embassies and beckons visitors to wander its quiet streets and linger in its walled gardens. Climb the bell tower of St Nicholas Church which was used to spy on the nearby American embassy during the communist era or stop by the John Lennon Wall to see a symbol of political protest for young Czechs in the 80s. Finish off with coffee and cake from the grand Café Savoy.

On your final morning, enjoy a hearty breakfast or relax in your hotel's spa while you await your transfer to the airport.

Those leaving later in the day may also enjoy a final stroll through Prague's Old Town, meandering along the narrow, twisting streets which wind through the picturesque interior, or a morning spent exploring one of Prague's less traditional Christmas Markets such as the Manifesto Winter Market, a new concept offering gourmet street food and design focused retail in converted shipping containers. Book one of the heated igloos which come complete with cozy blankets and a chilled bottle of Veuve Clicquot champagne for a truly special experience.

As you depart for your home, we hope you will look back on your Christmas holiday with great joy, fondly remembering the journey as "A Trip of a Lifetime!"
